American Distilling and Mfg., Inc. *Witch Hazel* was analyzed by according to American Distilling and Mfg., Inc. Standard Operating Procedure GC – ECDA (Gas Chromatography – Mass Spectroscopy). This method shows detection and identification at 1ppm for the analytes listed below. Of the lots tested, none were found to contain ≥ 1 mg/L of any of the compounds listed in the following table:
